Credits are split by state insurance & ethics CE credits (i.e. 9/3 = 9 state insurance credits / 3 ethics credits)

\*\*5 credit hours of CIMA for Virtual Super CE programs. (States that require a 100 question exam will receive 10 credits of CIMA.)

CFP – 10 credit hours = 50 question exam

CIMA – 5 Credit hours = 50 question exam

CIMA – 10 credit hours = 100 question exam

CPE (CPA) – 9/3 Credit hours = 50 question exam
